Actual Cost to Educate

The actual cost to educate a K-8 child is \$8,630, and a Pre-K child is \$4,690.

Prepayment discount

Receive a 1% prepayment discount if you pay the entire year's tuition by check before August 15th.

How to Qualify for a Parish Investment

To qualify for the parish investment in your child's education, you and your family must be registered at St. Joseph Parish, and you must be able to demonstrate that you are an identifiable contributing member.

Families who are registered and contributing members of other Catholic parishes may provide a signed and approved *Out of Parish Form* from their parish pastor, enabling that parish to pay the investment in their child's St. Joseph education.

FACTS

All tuition payments for St. Joseph Catholic School will be made through the FACTS Tuition Management Program. There is an initial setup fee. FACTS forms must be completed during the application process. **This year, all families are asked to fill out a Grand & Aid form through FACTS.** Grant & Aid will allow the Archdiocese to offer tuition assistance to families who qualify for a multi-child or a parishioner award. This will also be the basis for any families needing financial assistance.

Applicants must apply through FACTS to be considered for available grants and scholarships. Funds are available on a first-come, first-serve basis after the **application deadline of January 31st**, although applications will be accepted until all grants and scholarships have been awarded.

Once the application is accepted by the school, families will be asked to go online in order to setup both the enrollment packet and the FACTS account with the Grant & Aid application.
